



Brownsville Public Utilities Board (BPUB) announces temporary road closures at wastewater-upgrade project sites associated with the \$46 million dollar funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Streets affected by ARRA projects are as follows:

West Brownsville Sewer Rehabilitation

West 6th Street between Resaca Boulevard and West Madison Street (Closed; reopening late July 2011)

West 8th Street between West St Francis and West Fronton (Closed: reopening late June 2011)

Boca Chica and Central Blvd. Sewer Rehabilitation

Intersection of Boca Chica Street and Central Boulevard is closed throughout June. The contractor will install a gravity sewer main and estimates the closure will last until mid-July.

Regional Sewer Lift Station No. 64 and FM 802 Gravity Sewer Upgrades

Old Hwy 77 from Melinda Street to Charlie Clark Rd (closed reopening in late July 2011)

Southmost Wastewater Collection System and Lift Stations

Lima Street between Tampico Street and Southmost Road (Closed; reopening in Mid August 2011)

Downtown Lift Station & Force Main

East 6th Street from E. Ringgold Street to E. Jackson (Closed; reopening in late July 2011)
