TO: PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

The Specifications, and Contract Documents shall be modified as required by the following items:

Item 1-1

Construction Agreement, Article 3. Contract Time:

Section 1.1:

Delete the text “The Work shall be substantially completed in accordance with Article 14.8 of the General Conditions within 250 consecutive calendar days after the date when the Contract Time commences to run as provided in Article 2.3 of the General Conditions,” and replace with the following:

“The Work shall be substantially completed in accordance with Article 14.8 of the General Conditions within 330 consecutive calendar days after the date when the Contract Time commences to run as provided in Article 2.3 of the General Conditions,”

Item 1-2

Specifications, 01 11 00 – Summary of Work:

Section 1.02.B:

Delete the text, “Install utility-furnished transformer for Electrical Building 3” and replace with the following:

“Provide pad and secondary conductors for transformer for Electrical Building 3. Transformer and primary conductors to be furnished and installed by utility.”

Questions / Clarifications

Question 1-1 After reviewing the Bid documents the work associated with the new 2760 VA transformer is very vague. Section 01 11 00, 1.02B.4 states utility will provide transformer for contractor to install. What is normal is contractor builds the slab and secondary duct bank and cable. The utility builds the primary raceways or overhead etc. provides their own primary cables as well. The utility then sets the transformer and terminates all cables. Obviously we will not be allowed to install this transformer, BUT is the contractor expected to build the under ground duct bank from the existing tap box to the new transformer location or will utility provider do the work? If BPUB is doing the work should the contractor carry money in the Bid to pay for any construction charges BPUB may need to be paid for?

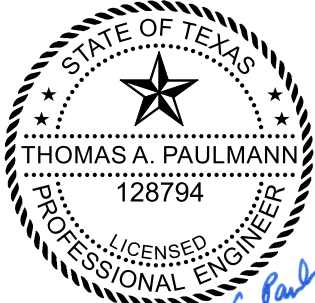
Answer 1-1 As indicated in the conduit schedule on E953, as well as Specification 26 05 00, §1.03/D, primary ductbank conduits P-001 and P-002 shall be provided by the contractor whereas the electric utility will provide and install the primary conductors. Contractor is responsible for ensuring work is done in accordance with the utility's design specifications and requirements per Specification 26 05 00, §1.03/F. BPUB confirmed the Contractor should not carry money in the Bid to pay for work designated in the Contract Documents to be performed by BPUB Electric.

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All items in conflict with this addendum are hereby deleted.
