

BPUB Touch-A-Truck: Bucket Truck Ride Guidelines

Participation Process:

1. Bucket Truck Ride Announcements:

Announcements for bucket truck demonstrations will be made every 30 minutes during the event.

2. Bucket Truck Ride Drawing Procedure

 Upon each announcement, interested attendees should proceed to the bucket truck staging area.

3. Safety Assessment

- The safety coordinator will vet attendees interested in a bucket ride to ensure they meet safety requirements.
- Once cleared, attendees will be issued a ticket by the drawing coordinator.

4. Ticket Distribution

- o The drawing coordinator will issue one ticket to each interested attendee.
- The drawing coordinator will place a matching ticket for each issued ticket into a tumbler.

5. Drawing Process

- When it's time for the scheduled ride, the drawing coordinator will draw one ticket from the tumbler.
- The attendee holding the matching ticket to the one drawn will be allowed to ride the bucket truck.
- The winning ticket will be announced three times, if no calim is made, then a new ticket will be drawn and announced.

6. Rides Limitations:

- o The bucket truck operator must accompany riders
- All riders must be at least 48 inches tall
- Rides are limited to:
 - One adult over 18 years of age
 - or an adult and child no older than 13 years old
- Must wear appropriate footwear and clothing
- o The rider's combined weight may not exceed 380 lbs.

7. Waivers:

 After each drawing, the winning rider(s) must complete a waiver form before participating in the bucket truck ride.

8. Redraw

 Riders who do not sign a waiver, refuse to abide by the rules or do not meet the ride requirements will forfeit their ride, and a new rider will be redrawn.



9. Safety Briefing:

• Before each ride, each rider must undergo a safety briefing to ensure all participants know the safety protocols.

10. Safety Equipment & Inspections

- Each participant will be secured with an appropriately sized harness and hard hat and directed up the safety railing.
- After each ride, the operators perform a safety check and prepare the bucket for the next ride.
- **11.** The process will repeat each new announcement.

Safety Rules and Guidelines

- A certified, experienced operator must accompany all riders at all times for the duration of the rides.
- All participants must be at least 48" tall
- Rides are limited to:
 - o one rider over 18 years of age
 - o or an adult and child no older than 13 years of age
- The rider's combined weight may not exceed 380 lbs
- All riders must wear helmets and securely fastened harnesses
- Participants must attend a pre-ride safety briefing
- All participants must sign a liability waiver
- Rides will reach up to 50% of the bucket truck's total height capacity
- Maximum ride time is one minute
- Participants may choose ride length and height within these limits
- The operator and rider will ensure clear communication for emergency stops

BPUB Rights

- BPUB may refuse rides to anyone perceived as a safety risk or do not comply with these rules.
- Rides may be halted due to adverse weather conditions.
