Why is it important to follow drought restrictions?

Did you know that not enough rain at the Falcon and Amistad reservoirs can cause serious water issues for our community? This is known as drought. During droughts, restrictions are put in place to ensure there's enough water for everyone to use.

Make sure to water when it's your turn:

- Check the schedule: Everyone takes turns watering the plants. It all depends on your address. Encourage your parents to check the BPUB website to find out when it's their turn.
- Car Washing: If your parents want to wash their cars at home, tell them to check the watering day schedule.
- Watch what you water: There's no need to wash buildings, use water to control dust, or let water run into the streets. Save it instead!

Talk to your parents about it, and together, we can save water, money, and the planet!

The power of water conservation is yours. Here are things you can do to help.

- Encourage your parents to plant drought-resistant plants to reduce the amount of water required for watering.
